SPRING STABILITY FUND REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS (RFAs)

Answers to Bidders Questions:

Question 1

“What sub-counties or districts should the project be implemented in?”

Answer 1

We would advise applicants to recommend piloting their activities in the SPRING’s six districts in the Acholi and Lango sub-regions: Amuru, Gulu, Pader, Kitgum, Oyam and Lira.

Question 2

“I am writing to inquire about the pre-registration process”. After pre-registration what next?

Answer 2

Before an applicant can apply for a SPRING STABILITY Fund grant, they must pre-register. Applicants can pre-register by accessing the SPRING website through the Announcements/Tenders link: www.springuganda.com and these only apply to those who have not pre-registered before in their lifetime with SPRING. Pre-registration is an easy process and should take no more than an hour. The pre-registration form can be emailed to the email address: proposals@springuganda.com.
